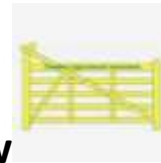

Important Dates

- **Closing date for entries:** Saturday **10th July 2026**
- **Show dates:** Saturday **8th** & Sunday **9th August 2026**

Entry Details – *(Pens are for animals only. Please state the number of animals and pens required on your entry form.)*

- **Entry Fee:** £10 per class
- **Pen Fee:** £10 per pen

Travel Money

Travel money is paid to exhibitors **bringing 3 or more animals (excluding calves)**.
Payment is **graduated based on distance to the showground (“as the crow flies”)**:

upto 10 miles - £10, upto 15 miles - £15, upto 20 miles - £20, upto 25 miles - £25, 25+ miles - £30

Prize Money

For all classes: **1st:** £20 **2nd:** £15 **3rd:** £10

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Please **report to the Biosecurity Officer** before unloading your lorry to ensure compliance with **current DEFRA regulations**.
- All cattle entered must produce **TB clearance certificates** if applicable.
- Each animal must have a valid **passport** and **movement certificate** on the day.
- **Do not unload** any lorries until advised.
- **All vehicle wheel arches must be disinfected** before arrival on the showground.
- Use the **Livestock Entrance** on the day.
- All animals must be **halter trained and led**.
- Exhibitors must comply with all **movement documentation requirements** to the satisfaction of **Surrey Trading Standards**.
- **All exhibitors must complete entry forms before the show.**

Show Day Requirements

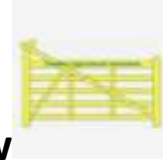
- **Arrival:** All cattle must be on the showground by **9:00 a.m.**
- **Judging:** Commences at **9:30 a.m.** on both days.
- **Judges:** To be advised.
- All cattle must **remain until after the Grand Parade** in the Main Ring on both days.

General Information

- **Admission** is at the discretion of the **Chertsey Agricultural Association**.
- All persons enter the **Livestock Areas at their own risk**.

Dexter Classes

| 5C | Dexter Bull – any age |

| 7C | Beef female born in 2024 |
| 8C | Beef female born in 2025 – yearling class |

 **The Eric Rayner Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the **Champion of Classes 6C–8C**.

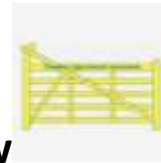
Open Classes – British Native Breeds

| 13C | Pairs – the best pair of animals of any native breed |

| 18C | Any native animal – led by Senior Young Handler (Minimum age: 13 years; Maximum age: 18 years on the day of show) |

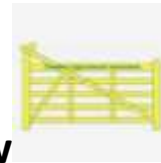
